Author of *Parenting in a Digital World*, Sergeant Cranford, will explain current technology teens are using and will give tools and actions plans to stay safe online.

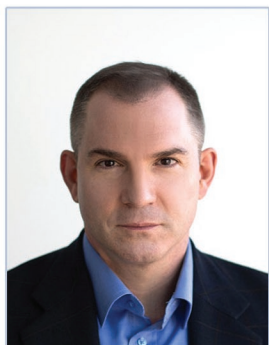
