

FAQs PEF Fall Enrichment 2023

When are the enrichment classes taking place?

Classes begin the week of September 18th (with the exception of Disney Dance at Soleado beginning September 26th; Hip Hop at Lunada Bay beginning September 27th; Cheer at Vista Grande beginning September 29th and Disney Dance at Montemalaga beginning on October 2).

How many enrichment classes are there?

Most classes have eight sessions. Exceptions are classes starting on September 26th, September 27th, September 29th, October 2nd and Friday classes. Check the ACTIVE registration site for class dates for each class offered.

Will there be any days that there are not enrichment classes?

Yes. There will not be any enrichment classes on September 25th (a student-free day). The make up for that class will be November 13th. There will not be any enrichment classes on October 31st. The make up for that class will be November 14th.

Is there supervision for my student when they are dismissed from school before the enrichment class starts?

Yes. 1st and 2nd grade students dismissed at 2:35pm will be supervised by the enrichment instructor before classes begin. Students can have a snack during this time or do school work. If a student is enrolled in Kid's Corner, they would go to Kid's Corner, and then will be brought to the enrichment class when it begins.

Kindergarten students will need to be supervised by an adult since they are dismissed earlier. Please check class descriptions to see if KinderKid Watch is offered for \$10 per class. (KinderKid Watch needs at least 5 students signed up to take place. If you sign up for a class and KinderKid Watch is canceled due to low enrollment, you will be fully refunded).

What happens if I have a scheduling conflict and need to cancel my registration?

Full refunds of tuition and fees are granted, less a \$25 processing fee if requested prior to September 8, 2023. No refunds will be granted after September 8, 2023. Email enrichment@pvpef.org to request a refund.

What happens if there aren't enough students in the class?

We will determine if a class is viable with enough students by September 12th. You will be notified about a class cancellation. You can either transfer to another enrichment class, or we will give you a full refund. You will be contacted by email.

What happens if my student can't attend a class?

Please email enrichment@pvpef.org to let us know if your student will be absent for an enrichment class. We do not pro-rate tuition for any missed classes.

How do I reach the instructor during class time?

If you need to pick up your student early, or if you are going to be late picking up your student, please call 310-378-8695 and leave a message.

Can my student only take classes at his/her homeschool?

No. Students may take classes at any school site. However, we do not provide transportation to or from school sites.

Are classes open to all elementary age students?

Yes. Appropriately aged students do not need to attend PVPUSD schools to attend PEF Enrichment classes.
