

FAQs PEF Spring 2026 Enrichment

When are the enrichment classes taking place?

Classes begin the week of March 9, 2026 and end the week of May 22, 2026.

How many enrichment classes are there?

The enrichment classes consist of 10 sessions, starting the week of March 9, 2026.

Will there be any days when there are no enrichment classes?

Enrichment classes follow the school calendar and are not held on days when school is not in session. There are no classes during Spring Break. Classes are also cancelled if an instructor is unavailable due to illness. For specific dates and any exceptions, please refer to the schedule of your selected class.

What time does my class start?

Most classes begin at 3:05 pm if they take place on an elementary campus. Some classes for younger students begin at 2:40 pm. Please see your confirmation email for specific class details.

Is supervision provided for students who are dismissed from school before the enrichment class begins?

Students enrolled in Kids' Corner are escorted from Kids' Corner to their enrichment class and then returned to Kids' Corner once the class ends.

Supervision is provided for 1st and 2nd grade students. Students dismissed at 2:35 pm will be supervised by the enrichment instructor until the class begins at 3:05 pm. During this time, students can have a snack or do homework.

⚠️ Special note for TK/Kindergarten students:

TK & Kindergarten students enrolled in enrichment classes must be supervised by an adult after school dismisses and before the enrichment class begins, as they are dismissed earlier than other students.

What happens if I have a scheduling conflict and need to cancel my registration?

Full refunds of tuition and fees, less a \$25 processing fee, are granted if requested prior to 5:00 pm on Monday, March 2, 2026. No refunds will be granted after March 3, 2025. Please email enrichment@pvpef.org to request a refund.

My child wants to take a different class than I signed up for. Can I transfer my child to a different class?

Yes, if there is space available. Call or email the PEF office and we will make the transfer for you.

What happens if there aren't enough students in the class?

We will determine if a class is viable with enough students by March 4. If a class is cancelled, you will be notified by email. You may either transfer to another class or receive a full refund.

What happens if my student cannot attend a class?

Please email enrichment@pvpef.org to notify us if your student will be absent. We cannot pro-rate tuition for missed classes.

How do I reach the instructor during class time?

If you need to pick up your student early or will be late picking up your student, please call the PEF Office at 310-378-2278.

Can my student take classes at other school sites?

Yes. However, PEF does not provide transportation to or from school sites. Students may not enter the campus until school has been dismissed at 3 pm.

Are classes open to all elementary age students?

Yes. PEF enrichment classes are open to all appropriately aged, independent students, regardless of whether they attend PVPUSD schools.

Special note for TK/Kindergarten students:

TK & Kindergarten students enrolled in enrichment classes must be supervised by an adult after school dismisses and before the enrichment class begins, as they are dismissed earlier than other students.
